

Working America, a community affiliate of the AFL-CIO, will be conducting a door-to-door organizing drive in the great township of Whitehall starting on the 23rd of April 2024, and continuing until at least July 2024.

Working America is a chartered affiliate of the AFL-CIO with nearly four million members who are associate members of the AFL-CIO. Working America is a not-for-profit 501(c)(5) labor organization that engages in education, and legislative and political advocacy, in support of good jobs, education, living wages, secure pensions, affordable health care, retirement security, and other issues of importance to working families.

Working America's canvassers are professionally trained and may at times carry prominently displayed picture identification cards and wear red safety vests that display their affiliation with Working America. The purpose of our organizing drive is to educate working people about issues that affect them, and sign up new members. Our organizers do not sell any kind of products. Our canvassing typically operates in the late afternoon and evening, from 3:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. – the hours when working people are most likely to be home. Courts have recognized the right of canvassers to canvass during these hours, notwithstanding any local or state curfews.

Because Working America is engaged in constitutionally-protected political speech in its canvassing operation, it is not required to obtain a permit prior to engaging in this activity.
