MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- U.S. Citizenship is required.
- Valid Pennsylvania Vehicle Driver's License or an eligibility to obtain a Pennsylvania Driver's License.
- Possess an Associates' Degree, or sixty (60) credit hours from an accredited College or University, or two years of service as a full-time Police Officer as of the deadline for submitting application. (60 semester credit hours are waived for those applicants with at least four years of full active military duty with an honorable discharge.)
- Be physically and mentally fit to perform the essential duties of a Police Officer.
- Be twenty-one (21) years old before the deadline for submitting the completed application.
- Must be able to meet the Township residency requirement of 10 miles within six months of hire.
- Must be of good moral character, judgment, and integrity.

AUTOMATIC DISQUALIFIERS

- Conviction of a felony
- Use of illegal drugs in violation of the Whitehall Township Employment Drug Policy
- Default of a student loan (insured by the U.S. Government)
- Failure of an department-administered urinalysis drug test
- Failure to register with the Selective Service System (for males only)

WRITTEN TEST

- 70% score to pass, or a percentage set by the testing agency and approved by the Civil Service Commission.
- Score within the top 50 applicants.

JULY 10, 2021 8:30 a.m. (arrive at 7:30 a.m.)

PHYSICAL FITNESS TEST

Each exercise will be scored as PASS/FAIL. If an applicant fails one event, they fail the entire test and will not advance to the written test.

Vertical Jump- Applicant will be provided three attempts to jump as high as possible from a standing position. The standard is 15".

1 Minute Sit-Ups- Applicants will have 1 minute to complete 28 sit-ups.

300 Meter Run- Applicant will run 300 meters on a level surface within 70.1 seconds.

Push-ups- Applicant will place their hands on the ground, approximately shoulder width apart. Applicant's feet may be up to 12" apart. The body must be in a straight line from shoulders to ankles. 24 correct push-ups must be performed to pass this test.

1.5 Mile Run-The applicant will run a level 1.5 mile course within 15 minutes and 55 seconds.
