What is Schnitzel? :

It's anything you bread and then fry or sauté,
Traditionally it's Pork

What is the difference between a Bockwurst and a Bratwurst? :

A Bockwurst gets boiled, a Bratwurst gets grilled.

Why don't we serve our food as sandwiches? :

We serve our food as true to its German roots as possible, which is why we do not serve it sandwich style.

Our Sauces:

Zigeuner (Gypsy) Sauce :

Similar to a marinara sauce just a little bit sweeter and tangier

Curry Sauce :

Similar to a BBQ sauce with a curry flavor, slightly sweet and spicy

Jäger Sauce :

A cream based mushroom sauce, with domestic and Porcini mushrooms
